FAQ's for MaxEd Best Project Awards 2017

1. What are the next steps for participating in the MaxEd Best Project Awards 2017 event
 - You need to pay a registration fee of Rs 500 by bank transfer (details given below)
 - You need to appear for final evaluation round to be held at CETAA Hall, CET School of Management, Trivandrum on 23rd August
 - You need to come prepared with a presentation not more than 15 to 20 slides on your project/internship covering
 - Clear problem definition/role description
 - Understanding of challenges in solving the problem/handling the internship role
 - Research methodology & design /Training/Induction process
 - Data collection and analysis/tasks handled
 - Use of technology/tools
 - Research output/achievements
 - Degree of relevance to industry/company/function
 - Learnings/skill enrichment
 - Guide/mentor name and guidance

2. Do I need to submit the final draft of Project/Internship?
 - You need not submit the final draft of Project/Internship.
 - The participant whose abstract is accepted and who has paid the registration fee can attend the second stage of the Project Awards.

3. Do I need to pay a registration fee and how should I pay the same?

The participant whose abstract has been accepted for the Best Project Awards has to pay a nominal registration fee of Rs.500. Payment should be made in favor of

4. Do I need to inform MaxEd after paying the registration fee by bank transfer

Yes, you can inform us on your payment by sending a e-mail to maxedlearn@gmail.com so that we can verify and confirm the receipt of the amount and registration for the event.

5. When is the last date for payment of Registration Fee?

The last date for payment of Registration Fee is 7th August 2017. Late payments will not be accepted.

6. Is there a separate registration fee for the project/internship guides?

There is no registration fee for the project/internship guides.

7. Do I need to be physically present for the presentation during MaxEd Best Project Awards 2017?

The participant needs to be physically present for the presentation and as well as the Q & A's as it forms the most important part of the evaluation. However guides/mentors need not be physically present for the presentation.

8. Where should I come for the presentation?

The program is hosted by CET School of Management, Trivandrum and the venue is Cetaa Hall. The participants need to be physically present and register at the venue on 23rd August 2017 by 9 am.

9. What if I pay the registration fee and I am not able to be physically present for MaxEd Best Project Awards 2017?

If you have paid the registration fee of Rs. 500 and you are not able to be physically present for the MaxEd Best Project Awards 2017 at CET School of Management on 23rd August 2017, you are eligible to get a Certificate of Appreciation highlighting "Project/Internship of Mr/Ms..... on the topicwas nominated for the MaxEd Best Student Project Awards 2017"

10. Do we need to bring a proof of the Project/Internship?

It is better to carry a proof of the Project/Internship and we will recommend you to keep the original/copy of the report for reference and authenticity.

11. Should I carry an ID Proof on 23rd August 2017?

The participant should necessarily carry an ID proof like Aadhar card or passport or license and the proof of payment of Registration Fees so as to avoid hassles on the day.

12. Is there any dress code for the Awards Function?

All the participants should necessarily be in formals for the Awards Function since participants from the industry and academia would be attending the same.

13. How much time is allotted for presentation?

The maximum time allotted for presentation is 15 mints which includes Q& A session.

14. Will this work be published?

The work will not be published in any form. Only selected works will be edited and published in the proceedings book after getting permission from the participant and the guide.

15. What would be the duration of the Awards Function?

The Awards Function will be from 9:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The detailed program schedule will be mailed separately.
